Dear Judge Langston:

This is to certify that this is a true and correct report of the findings in the above case as derived from the following: 1) Historical data from outside sources; 2) Medical history, physical and neurological examinations; 3) Iaboratory and other physical studies; 4) Psychological assessment by staff psychologist; and 5) Psychiatric evaluation including direct psychiatric examination by the examining psychiatrist.

Diagnosis: Axis I - Psychoactive Substance Abuse Not Otherwise Specified; Axis II - No Diagnosis.

The defendant appears to be aware of the nature of the charges and the proceedings taken against him. He is capable of cooperating effectively with an attorney in the preparation of his defense.

At the time of the commission of the alleged offense, the defendant did not lack the capacity to appreciate the criminality of his conduct or to conform his conduct to the requirements of the law.

He is ready to return to Court for disposition. The sheriff of Pulaski County is today being notified to send for this patient.
